Choose one or more of the following methods to show your support of the youth.

### **Method One:**

**Bidding at Auction** 

- Hogs, Lambs, Steers, & Goats are sold by the pound.
- Turkeys, Ducks, & Rabbits are sold by animal
- Chickens are sold by Pen of three
- Honey is sold by bottle(3)

Harvesting, cutting, wrapping, and curing/ smoking of the meat is paid for separately **by the purchaser** at a meat shop.

You can sign up to buy now or at the auction.

If you cannot make it to the Auction, ask about proxy bidding.

### **Method Two:**

Purchase & "Turn" the Animal.

After buying you may "Turn" your purchase to a wholesale buyer and only pay the

difference between the "wholesale value" and your bid price. This does not affect what the youth receives.

### **Method Three: Add On**

You can choose to make a financial donation to a participant to help support their project, or to a group of participants, or to all participants participating in a specific species or a general donation to the auction to be shared by all participants as a blanket donation.

The CCJLA is a non-profit organization. Some, or all your support may be tax deductible.
